Nexperia Response

Nexperia facilities

Production in the Nexperia Back-end facility in Guangdong province (China) and as well as our Frontends in Europe continue to run. Although the loading in our Manchester facility is reduced, it continues to serve the current customer demand. The government of Malaysia announced today to extend the lockdown with two weeks, until end April 28. The government in the Philippines announced earlier this week to extend the lockdown of the main island until end of April. Since Nexperia has planned for all eventualities, we can respond quickly and both our facilities in Cabuyao (Philippines) and Seremban (Malaysia) continue to run a 'skeleton crew' operation in accordance with the official government approval.

With a 'skeleton crew', Nexperia can continue producing and shipping while following the local government regulations. Within this restricted set up, we have been able to secure an increased manufacturing capacity for the extended 'skeleton crew' period in our facility in Cabuyao (Philippines). However, it could still result in a limited production capacity for parts of our product portfolio, where the company selects to produce those products to keep inventories on a healthy level.

The full restart of the facility in Seremban is now planned for April 29, and Cabuyao May 2, depending on government updates.

Local response teams are in place. We are strictly following the global WHO COVID-19 advice. As well as the recommendations of local government and health authorities. The recent announcement from the government in Thailand has no impact on the operations in Bangkok and business continues to run as normal.

The required adaptions of the orderbook for our Seremban and Cabuyao portfolio is being executed and Customer Service team will share supply impacts with our customers.

External Suppliers

Nexperia's key suppliers continue to fully support Nexperia for both manufacturing material deliveries and end-customer production.

General

Revised demand signals from our customers are being processed and we encourage customers to update their demand signal to us on short notice to enable proper planning and priorities.

This is an extraordinary situation mandated by government regulations. Nexperia will do its utmost for a continuous supply of goods, but we will not accept any liability for any shortages in delivery or other consequences caused by this force majeure situation.
